RESOLUTION BY THE COMMUNITY EVENTS, BEAUTIFICATION, AND CULTURAL COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE USE OF VILLAGE STREETS AND RIGHT OF WAY FOR THE ROTARY POST PROM ON THE 19TH AND 20TH OF MAY, 2012

WHEREAS, Racine Rotary Foundation Inc. has requested to use various Sturtevant Village roads and right of way for its Post Prom activities on the 19th and 20th of May, 2012;

WHEREAS, the Village is willing to grant the request of Racine Rotary Foundation Inc. but only under the conditions set forth in this resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Sturtevant, Racine County, Wisconsin does hereby resolve:

1. That the use of the Village streets and right of way as set forth in Exhibit A which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for the Rotary Post Prom from 6:00 p.m. on May 19, 2012 until approximately 12:30 a.m. on May 20, 2012 is authorized and approved subject to the terms and conditions set forth herein.
2. That the Police Chief and the Public Works Director are authorized to establish any road closures or lane closures that they deem as necessary for safety during the event.
3. That the event shall be at no cost to the Village of Sturtevant and that any costs for law enforcement or other services from the Village shall be paid for by Racine Rotary Foundation Inc. or by some other party other than the Village of Sturtevant.
4. That this permission is contingent on Racine Rotary Foundation Inc. providing the Village Administrator with documentation that the Village of Sturtevant, its officers, employees and agents are covered by liability insurance as an additional insured for the event with minimum limits of \$1million and with no limitations.
5. That this permission is contingent on Racine Rotary Foundation Inc. providing the Village Administrator with documentation that the City of Racine, its officers, employees and agents are covered by liability insurance as an additional insured for the event with minimum limits of \$1million and with no limitations.
6. That this permission is contingent on the City of Racine and the Village of Sturtevant entering into an agreement acceptable to the Village Administrator, whereby the City of Racine Police Department will provide personnel for the event at no cost to the Village of Sturtevant and such agreement is authorized and approved subject to approval by the Village Administrator.
7. That the Village Clerk and the Village President are authorized to execute any agreements, contracts or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution and such agreements, contracts or other documents are hereby authorized and approved subject to approval by the Village Administrator.


