**RESOLUTION BY THE PUBLIC WORKS AND CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENTS COMMITTEE GRANTING PERMISSION TO HIAWATHA
SNO CHIEFS AND THE CALEDONIA ESKIMOS TO USE VILLAGE
PROPERTY FOR A SNOWMOBILE TRAIL**

WHEREAS, Hiawatha Sno Chiefs and Caledonia Eskimos snowmobile clubs, have requested to be allowed to use the eastern edge of the Kirkorian Nature Preserve parcel for a snowmobile trail;

WHEREAS, a snowmobile trail has run along this area for many years and the Village Board believes that it is appropriate to allow this recreational activity.

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Sturtevant, Racine County, Wisconsin does hereby resolve:

1. That the use of the village property as set forth in Exhibit A which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for a snowmobile trail to be created and groomed by the Hiawatha Sno Chiefs and Caledonia Eskimos is authorized and approved subject to the conditions set forth herein.
2. That the use of the snowmobile trail shall be at no cost to the Village of Sturtevant.
3. That Hiawatha Sno Chiefs and Caledonia Eskimos shall mark, sign and groom said snowmobile trail.
4. That the use of Village property other than the property specifically identified in this resolution for snowmobile activities is strictly prohibited.
5. That the Village of Sturtevant reserves the right to revoke the permission granted in this resolution at any time for any reason or for no reason at the Village Board's sole discretion.
6. The Hiawatha Snow Chiefs and Caledonia Eskimos are exempt from the closing times stated in Section 9.185(1) of the Village of Sturtevant Municipal Code.
