





The Racine Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program encourages you to bring harmful chemicals from around the home to the permanent collection site.
Collection on every 3rd Saturday:
April, May, June, July, September, October

For Racine, Sturtevant, Elmwood Park, Caledonia and Mt. Pleasant Residents

Caledonia and Mt. Pleasant Residents are limited to the June, July, August Events in 2009!

Household Items

- Artist and hobby paint
- Cooking oil – used
- Floor/wax stripper*
- Fluorescent and compact light bulbs
- Metal cleaners
- Mothballs
- Oven or drain cleaners
- Polish/spot remover w/solvent*
- Rechargeable/disposable batteries **
- Thermometers w/mercury

Home Improvement

- Adhesives, glues with solvent*
- Cleaners, solvent based
- Concrete cleaner (acid)
- Furniture stripper
- Oil based paint
- Paint remover or stripper
- Paint thinner/turpentine
- Rust remover
- Varnish
- Wood preservative

Automotive

- Auto body repair products
- Brake fluid
- Carburetor cleaner
- Degreasers
- Gasoline, fuels
- Solvent based car waxes
- Transmission fluid

Yard & Garden

- Driveway sealer
- Fertilizer with weed killer
- Insect or bug killer
- Kerosene
- Lighter fluid
- Motor oil mixtures
- Pool chemicals
- Rat/rodent poison
- Weed killer

* Solvent-containing products have the words: flammable, combustible or contains petroleum distillates on the label. Any products with acetone, xylene and methylene chloride should be saved for collection.

** Retailers such as Batteries Plus also accept rechargeable batteries, or call 1-800-8-BATTERY.

DO NOT BRING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

Lead Acid Batteries	Refrigerators or other appliances
Ammunition/Explosives/Fireworks	Latex paint (use a 'paint dry' product)
Empty containers	Medical wastes
Fire extinguishers	Radioactive wastes
Propane tanks or cylinders	Smoke detectors

Agricultural, Institutional or Business Wastes can be collected by special arrangement. Please see the City of Racine web site for more details.
