RESOLUTION BY THE FINANCE AND BUDGETARY COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE GRANTING OF ANY NECESSARY EASEMENTS, LICENSES AND APPROVALS TO ALLOW FOR THE INSTALLATION OF CITY BUS SHELTERS IN THE VILLAGE OF STURTEVANT

WHEREAS, the City of Racine has contacted the Village of Sturtevant and requested permission to use Village owned land and right of way which is located south of the southern curb of Rayne Road at 92nd Street to install a city bus shelter; and

WHEREAS, the City of Racine has contacted the Village of Sturtevant and requested permission install a city bus shelter located 200 feet south of Rayne Road on the eastside of 96th Street

WHEREAS, the construction of the bus shelters will be paid for, installed, and maintained by the City of Racine; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to grant certain easements, licenses and other approvals in order to allow this to take place.

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Sturtevant, Racine County, Wisconsin does hereby resolve:

1. That the granting of necessary easements, licenses, and/or other approvals in order to allow the City of Racine to install a bus shelter on Village owned property and right of way located south of the southern curb of Rayne Road at 92nd Street and to install a bus shelter located within the easterly right of way of 96th Street in the Village of Sturtevant is authorized and approved subject to final review by the Village Administrator.
2. The bus shelter located approximately 200 feet south of Rayne Road on the eastside of 96th Street will not be approved for installation until the Village received a copy of written permission from property owner allowing the bus shelter to be constructed partially on their property.
3. The Village President and the Village Clerk are authorized to sign any easements, agreements or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
