**RESOLUTION BY THE PARKS, RECREATION, AND EVENTS
COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE USE OF VILLAGE STREETS FOR THE
JINGLE BELL RUN ON DECEMBER 6, 2014**

WHEREAS, Arthritis Foundation Upper Midwest Region Inc. has requested to use approximately 5 km. of Sturtevant Village roads and pedestrian paths for a race on December 6, 2014;

WHEREAS, Arthritis Foundation Upper Midwest Region Inc. will reimburse the Village for any costs associated with the race;

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Sturtevant, Racine County, Wisconsin does hereby resolve:


1. That the use of the Village streets and pedestrian paths as set forth in Exhibit A which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for the Jingle Bell Run on December 6, 2014 is authorized and approved subject to the conditions set forth herein.
2. That the Police Chief and the Public Works Director are authorized to establish any road closures or lane closures that they deem as necessary for safety during the race.
3. That the event shall be at no cost the Village of Sturtevant and that any costs for law enforcement or other services from the Village shall be paid for by Arthritis Foundation Upper Midwest Region Inc.
4. That all snow removal activities and costs for the Jingle Bell Run shall be the responsibility of Arthritis Foundation Upper Midwest Region Inc.
5. That this permission is contingent on Arthritis Foundation Upper Midwest Region Inc. providing the Village Administrator with documentation that the Village of Sturtevant is covered by liability insurance for the event with minimum limits of \$1million.
