Highway 11 (Durand Avenue)
Sturtevant, 99th St. to 91st St.
Racine County

The reconstruction of Highway 11 (Durand Ave.) under a Wisconsin Department of Transportation contract with Payne and Dolan is to begin in the beginning of August. This project involves the reconstruction of Highway 11 from 99th Street to 91st Street. The work will consist of repaving the roadway as well as repairing sidewalk and curb & gutter. During this project the Canadian Pacific Railroad will also be reconstructing the railroad crossing on Highway 11 between 99th Street and Wisconsin Ave.

Highway 11 (Durand Ave.) will be closed to through traffic during construction operations with a detoured route signed accordingly as part of this contract. Access will be maintained one way in each direction for local traffic and emergency vehicles at all times except for a two week railroad closure starting August 13th. During this time the Railroad will post a detour utilizing I-94, Highway 20, and Highway 31. This project is expected to be completed and opened by October 2008.

It is the Contractor's responsibility to provide and maintain safe access throughout the life of the contract to all residential and business properties within the construction project limits. Residential driveway access will be open for service at all times except while work is being performed at the driveway access area. For commercial driveways access will be open to public at all times except while work is being performed on Highway 11 at the driveway access area(s). I ask for your patience, because the Contractor's work may cause some inconveniences.

If you know the location of any of your property corners which abut the construction limits, please notify me. We will tie down these existing property pipes and after construction we will reset the property pipes to their original locations.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind everyone of the safety hazards around a construction project. Driving at a reduced speed will make it safer for everyone concerned. Also, a highway project makes a very dangerous but attractive playground for children. Please warn them of the dangers and please keep them clear of the construction area.
