RESOLUTION BY THE COMMUNITY EVENTS, BEAUTIFICATION AND CULTURAL COMMITTEE OFFICIALLY NAMING TWO STORMWATER RETENTION PONDS AS “THE PARKERSVILLE POND” AND “THE ST. BONAVENTURE POND”

WHEREAS, the Village of Sturtevant is in the process of constructing and establishing two storm water retention ponds and there is a need to officially name said ponds; and

WHEREAS, for many years the St. Bonaventure School was located in Sturtevant and served the youth of the community; and

WHEREAS, in its early years, Sturtevant was known as Parkersville.

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Sturtevant, Racine County, Wisconsin does hereby resolve:

1. That it formally and officially names the storm water retention pond which is being constructed near the intersection of Rayne Rd. and 90th St., as the “St. Bonaventure Pond” to commemorate the St. Bonaventure School which was in the Village of Sturtevant for many years.
2. That it formally and officially names the storm water retention pond which is being constructed near the intersection of Venice Ave . and Enterprise Dr., as the “Parkersville Pond” to commemorate an earlier name of the Village of Sturtevant.
3. That the Sturtevant Public Works Department is authorized to construct signs at suitable locations within the storm water pond areas which will indicate the official names of the retention ponds.
