

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-53

RESOLUTION BY THE VILLAGE OF STURTEVANT AUTHORIZING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT PLEASANT AND THE VILLAGE OF STURTEVANT, PURSUANT TO §§ 66.0301(6) AND 66.0305, WIS. STATS.

The Village Board of the Village of Sturtevant, Racine County, Wisconsin do resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, Wis. Stats. §66.0301 sets forth procedures whereby municipalities may provide for intergovernmental cooperation for purposes of furthering the public interests of each community; and

WHEREAS, Wis. Stats. §66.0301(6) provides a specific mechanism whereby two municipalities whose boundaries are immediately adjacent at any point may enter into a written agreement determining all or a portion of the common boundary line between them; and

WHEREAS, Village of Mount Pleasant and the Village of Sturtevant each desire that the boundary between them be re-established so that the subject area providing for certain land to be detached from Mount Pleasant and brought into Sturtevant and so that the boundary between Mount Pleasant and Sturtevant is well planned, with complimentary development on both sides of the boundary between the communities; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Mount Pleasant and the Village of Sturtevant have negotiated an intergovernmental agreement under Section 66.0301(6), Wis. Stat., including for revenue sharing as authorized under Section 66.0305, Wis. Stat., as allowed per statute (the “Intergovernmental Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, both parties desire to enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement attached as **Exhibit A** to further the public interests and objectives of both Mount Pleasant and Sturtevant and to provide for cooperation that is beneficial to citizens in both communities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT the President and Clerk are authorized and directed to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Village of Mount Pleasant and the Village of Sturtevant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Village intends the boundary change approved under this agreement to remain in effect after the term in the Intergovernmental Agreement and as authorized under Sec. 66.0103(6), Wis. Stat.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT all Village officials, offices, and employees are authorized and directed to take such steps as are lawful and necessary in furtherance of the agreement and the boundary change and the Clerk is directed to publish a copy of the Agreement as required by law.
