Dear Homeowner:

Remediation of 92nd Street from Chandler to Hulda Drive, 93rd Street from Durand to Hulda Drive, and Chandler Ave from 90th to 95th Street is scheduled to begin on Tuesday, May 31st. This project will take approximately eight weeks to complete with a projected completion date of July 22nd. As part of the construction, travel in this area will become difficult and hazardous due to movement of heavy equipment/trucks and so extra care must be taken throughout the project area. When possible, use alternative routes to your place of business or residence.

There are two phases to this project. The first phase consist of Sump Pump Sewer Line installation with laterals; sanitary sewer spot repairs; and remediation of the roadway surface (asphalt). Once the project is completed, home owners will have until June 1, 2012 to connect to the sump pump lateral. Payne and Dolan is the General Contractor for this phase.

Small and emergency vehicle traffic will be allowed during most of the project. However; there will be times when certain portions of the road and driveways will be closed to all traffic. This is necessary because no other options are available. For example, the actual installation of the final asphalt surface layer in July or trenching across your driveway for the sump pump installation. We will try to inform everyone in advance as we get closer to your area so can make any accommodations you may need.

Several days prior to working beginning, you could see installation of no parking signs. These signs will go in effect 24 hours after installation or if on a weekend at 1 AM on the Monday following the installation of the signs. No vehicles will be allowed to park in those designated areas while the signs are in placed. Vehicles found to be parked on the street are subjected to ticketing and towing/removal. We ask that you make all necessary arrangements in advance to move vehicles off the street.

The second phase is the relining of the sanitary sewer main line. This phase should not impact residential travel as much as the road project. This phase will not start until after the road project is completed (late July or early August). Residents need to be aware that high pressure water will be used to clean the main sewer lines. As stated in an earlier letter, residents are warned to take the necessary precaution to prevent or minimize the amount of water from being blown out of the toilet or drains that may occur during this process. Terra Environmental is the General Contractor for this phase of the project.

Garbage Collection and Mail: Every effort will be made to ensure there is no disruption to your normal garbage collection service. If you are missed or there is a problem with garbage collection, please contact my office. Mail delivery should not be effected by this project.

In closing, I want to thank you in advance for your cooperation and understanding. I will try to keep everyone posted as best as I can.
