**RESOLUTION BY THE STORM WATER AND WASTEWATER
COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING A SUMP PUMP EXEMPTION FOR JOYCE AND
BILL ANDERSEN PURSUANT TO SECTION 21.11(2)(c)3 OF THE
STURTEVANT MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, Joyce and Bill Anderson have requested an exemption to the connection requirement for their sump pump discharge to the storm drain pipe as required by Section 21.11(2)(c)1 for their property located at 3138 94th Street, Sturtevant, Wisconsin ; and

WHEREAS, the Sturtevant Municipal Code permits exemptions to the connection requirement if authorized by the Village Board.

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Sturtevant, Racine County, Wisconsin does hereby grants an exemption to the sump pump discharge connection requirement pursuant to the authority of Section 21.11(2)(c)3 of the Municipal Code under the terms and conditions as set forth in exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, and this exemption shall be effective as of the date of passage of this resolution.

Exhibit A-Resolution 2011-39

In accordance with the conditions stated in Ordinance 21.11 (2)(c) 3 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Sturtevant, this sump pump connection requirement exemption is issued to: Joyce and Bill Anderson under the following conditions:

This exemption is only for the property located at 3138 94th Street, Sturtevant WI.

This exemption is only valid while the property is owned by Joyce and Bill Andersen. Upon change of ownership, this exemption shall expire and the new owner will have six (6) months to fulfill the connection requirements of Ordinance 21.11. The sellers must advise the buyers of the connection requirement.

The owners have had their property inspected by a representative of the Village, and it was demonstrated that there is no adverse impact as a result of the french drain method of sump pump discharge.

The owners must allow for additional follow up inspections by a representative of the Village when conditions warrant.

The owners must properly maintain the French drain method of sump pump discharge and keep the operations in good working order. The owners must not allow sump pump runoff to discharge onto neighboring properties, across sidewalks or into the street. If this occurs, the Village Board reserves the right to rescind this exemption upon investigation.

The Village Board reserves the right to require the owners to submit to a televising of the sewer connection at the property listed above to ensure to the Village's satisfaction that there is no cross connection of sump pump discharge in to the sanitary sewer. This inspection would be done at the Village's expense and may be without notice.

This exemption is non-transferable and all conditions must be met at all times. Not meeting any condition at any time may be grounds for rescinding this exemption and enforcing the connection requirements.

This exemption is deemed in force as of June 22, 2011.
