RESOLUTION BY THE PUBLIC WORKS AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR PAINTING AT THE STURTEVANT DEPOT

WHEREAS, the Village of Sturtevant received bids for the painting of items at the Sturtevant Depot which are in need of paint; and

WHEREAS, at this time the Village would like to proceed with said painting project; and

WHEREAS, Postorino Decorating is found to be the lowest responsible responsive bidder.

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Sturtevant, Racine County, Wisconsin does hereby resolve:

1. That the awarding of a contract to Postorino Decorating of Racine, Wisconsin, in the amount of \$12,830.00 for painting at the Sturtevant Depot, as described in exhibit A which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is authorized and approved and the Village President and the Village Clerk are authorized to sign any agreements or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
2. That the funds for said contract and said project shall be taken from Fund 210 from account # 210-52300-290.
3. That the total costs for the project shall not exceed \$13,000.00. That the Village Administrator is authorized to execute change orders provided that the total cost of the project does not exceed \$13,000.00.

Exhibit A- Resolution 2011-42

Train Depot Painting Scope of Work

Shelter buildings (x4) metal frames, trash cans, bike rack, and handrails work

- Power tool clean and sand rusted areas as needed.
- Sand all surfaces to receive coatings.
- Apply two (2) coats of Sherwin Williams Macropoxy 646 (Epoxy Primer).
- Apply two (2) full coat of Sherwin Williams Hi Solids polyurethane. Color to match existing bronze tone.

Prep and Paint 23 walkway exterior light poles and 2 decorative wall mounted lights on towers

- Solvent wash surface areas.
- Apply one (1) full coat of aluminum primer.
- Apply one (1) full coat of polyurethane epoxy.

Work to be completed Monday thru Friday 7:00 am 3:30pm

Three contractors showed up for walk through on May 27th and only two submitted quotes.

Thomas Mason Company submitted a quote for \$21,924.00. They are out of Milwaukee and did the work last year on the towers.

Postorino Decorating from Racine submitted a quote for \$12,830.00. They were recommended by Architects and Assoc. They have experience doing this type of work.

I specified the Sherwin Williams epoxy primer and polyurethane to be used for the project.

Funding would come from Train Depot Acct (currently \$77,000). Work would be done in August when I am back.
