Sturtevant Announces That The Holiday Train Is Coming To Sturtevant

Sturtevant Village President Steve Jansen announced today that the Canadian Pacific Holiday Train will make its annual stop in Sturtevant on Tuesday December 9, 2008 at the Sturtevant Depot from 6:45-7:45 p.m. The Sturtevant Depot is located at 9900 E. Exploration Court in the Renaissance Business Park. The Holiday Train brings entertainers to stops where they perform for the people who gather to look at and admire the brightly decorated train. This year, the entertainers include Melanie Doane and Shaun Verreault. The event is for a good cause in that it raises food and money for local food banks. Event goers are asked to bring a non perishable food donation for the Racine County Food Bank. Each year, the stop in Sturtevant has brought in food and donations for the Racine County Food Bank. This year, donations are especially needed.

Last year, hundreds of people came and enjoyed the event. Each year the event has attracted more individuals and families. To accommodate the anticipated people, the Village has arranged with two local businesses in the Renaissance Park to allow event goers to park in their lots. Event parking will be marked with signs. In addition, shuttle buses will be running and will transport people from the shuttle stops to the train depot. Exploration Drive will be closed to traffic except for handicapped parking. The following businesses have generously offered the use of their parking lots: Andis Company and BRP USA Inc. The shuttle buses are being provided courtesy of JohnsonDiversey Inc.

Jansen stated “ This is a great event for Sturtevant and for the whole Racine community. We invite everyone to bring a food donation and come down , see the Holiday Train and listen to some great entertainment.”
