All interested persons are invited to attend an open-house style public information meeting to discuss the upcoming resurfacing and intersection safety improvements of Washington Avenue. A project location map is attached.


The meeting will take place in the Mount Pleasant Village Hall, 8811 Campus Drive, Community Room 1 (B109) on December 15, 2011, from 5 – 7 p.m. Representatives from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will be available to discuss the proposed project and address any questions or concerns.

The purpose of the project is to improve safety at the intersections of Highway H and at 90th Street, including new traffic signals, pedestrian crosswalks, removing unused driveways along Washington Avenue, and potentially an advance warning beacon west of the Canadian Pacific Railway overpass. The project also includes rehabilitating the pavement on WIS 20 from Wisconsin St./Fancher Rd. (County H North) to 90th Street, a distance of approximately one half mile. The existing pavement was placed in 1979 and repaired and overlaid in 1996 and 1999. All work is expected to be completed within the existing right-of-way.

Construction is tentatively scheduled for 2014. WIS 20 will be open to through traffic with temporary lane restrictions during construction. Access to adjacent businesses and properties will be maintained throughout the project.
