RESOLUTION BY THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND REDEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE ADOPTING A PLANNING MAP FOR THE VILLAGE OF STURTEVANT AS PART OF THE RACINE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING PROCESS

WHEREAS, in 1999, Governor Thompson signed into law what is referred to as the "Smart Growth" legislation.

WHEREAS, all local governments (cities, towns, and villages) and the County are required to adopt a comprehensive plan by January 1, 2010 in order to enforce zoning, subdivision and official mapping ordinances.

WHEREAS, these ordinances must be consistent with the adopted comprehensive plan by January 1, 2010.

WHEREAS, in Racine County, all eighteen local communities are working cooperatively with the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (SEWRPC), County Planning and Development, and UW-Extension to create a multi-jurisdictional comprehensive plan.

NOW THEREFORE, the Village of Sturtevant Board of Trustees does hereby adopt the RECOMMENDED LAND USE PLAN FOR THE VILLAGE OF STURTEVANT: 2035 as the comprehensive planning map for the Village of Sturtevant, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, and the Clerk is directed to send a copy of said plan to Racine County and SEWRPAC to be included in the Racine County comprehensive planning process.
