**AN ORDINANCE BY THE FINANCE AND BUDGETARY COMMITTEE TO AMEND
SUBSECTION 5.11 (2) AND (3) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE
OF STURTEVANT, WISCONSIN, IN REGARD TO RESCUE FEES, FIRE CALLS ON
HIGHWAYS AND HAZARDOUS WASTE CLEAN UP**

The Village Board of the Village of Sturtevant, Racine County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

That Subsection 5.11(2) and (3) of the Village of Sturtevant Code of Ordinances is hereby be revised and amended to read as follows:

5.11 FEES FOR TRANSPORT IN RESCUE SQUAD AND FIRE CALLS ON HIGHWAYS

(2) Any person receiving transport in a Village of Sturtevant Fire Department rescue squad shall be billed by a billing service hired by the Village of Sturtevant within 60 days of such transport; the payments shall be deposited into the general fund, a fee as follows:

(a) For Advanced Life Support (ALS) services:

Village Resident \$550.00

Non-Resident \$600.00

(b) For Basic Life Support (BLS) services:

Village Resident \$400.00

Non-Resident \$450.00

(c) Loaded Mileage Charge

\$12.00 per mile

(d) Non-transport Charge

\$100.00 plus supplies/drugs

(3) Charges for fire calls on highways.

- (a) There is hereby imposed upon and charged a fire call charge to the owner or user at the time of the fire call of the property involved in a fire call response by the Sturtevant Fire Department on any highway within the Village of Sturtevant. The fire call charge shall be in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and shall cover the cost of such fire call.
 - (b) The Public Safety Director or Designee of the Village of Sturtevant shall submit statements for such charges to all such owners or users of the property subject to a fire call on such highways as soon as practical following the completion of the fire call. All such charges shall be paid to the Village Clerk, who shall report monthly to the Public Safety Director or Designee as to all such charges as were collected during the preceding month.
- (4) Cleanup of Spills. Any person who possesses or controls a hazardous material or infectious agent which was discharged or who caused the discharge of a hazardous material or infectious agent shall reimburse the Village for actual and necessary expenses incurred by the Village or its agent to contain, remove or dispose of the hazardous substance or infectious agent or take any other appropriate action which is deemed appropriate under the circumstances. There is hereby imposed upon and charged a charge to the owner of the property on which was discharged or user who caused the discharge of a hazardous material or infectious agent at the time of the call and response by the Sturtevant Fire Department and such charge shall be in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) in addition to the described actual and necessary expenses.
