yard waste and invasive species



paper lunchbags



coffee grounds and paper filters



leftovers



brown paper grocery bags



newspaper, paper napkins as a means to control moisture, not in bulk or large quantities.



paper lawn/leaf bags.

NO LONGER ACCEPTED



compostable products



biobag or any kind of "plastic" compostable bag



compostable or biodegradable cutlery including vegware or spudware



paper and pressed fiber lunch trays, plates and bowls



waxed or wax coated paper

**please NO hand towels from the restroom.*

INTERNAL COLLECTION METHODS



1 Use a 5-gallon bucket and a brown paper grocery bag.



2 Use a 30-gallon landscaping bag and a slim jim container. Cut the corners and fold down to get a good fit in your bin.



**When you're ready to dispose of your compost, roll down the top to seal it closed. Instead of pulling the liner from your bin, take the entire container to your outside compost receptacle and dispose of your compost. This will insure no ripping or mess when using a paper liner.*
