WHEREAS, the an AED will greatly increase the chances of survival of a sudden cardiac arrest patient and AED's are a medical device that is easy to use and can analyze a heart rhythm and if necessary deliver an electrical shock to the heart to help the heart re-establish and effect rhythm; and

WHEREAS, staff has evaluated quotes for the four AED's and the associated equipment and recommend the purchase of the AED's and equipment; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Sturtevant, Racine County, Wisconsin does hereby resolve:

The Village of Sturtevant proceed with the purchase of four Automated External Defibrillators, and associated equipment, from the Henry Schein Company at a price not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5000.00)
