**RESOLUTION BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF  
STURTEVANT AUTHORIZING THREE-YEAR REPAYMENT AGREEMENT  
FOR POLICE OFFICERS**

WHEREAS, THE Village of Sturtevant has found that there is considerable costs involved with the hiring process, training, equipment and ancillary items with newly hired Police Officers; and

WHEREAS, the Village incurs costs associated with all the collective processes, training, equipment, FTO time and ancillary items that substantially exceed \$9500.00; and

WHEREAS, the Village understands that is a new hired/candidate Police Offer leaves the employment of the Village within the first three years of service that the aforementioned costs are not fully recouped; and


WHEREAS, the Village will recoup the aforementioned costs and as outlined in the exhibit titled "Village of Sturtevant Three-Year Repayment Agreement that will be a required to be signed by the Police Officer; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Sturtevant, Racine County, Wisconsin does hereby resolve:

Each newly hired Police Officer shall be required to sign the Three-Year Repayment Agreement as noted in the exhibit and shall be bound to this repayment should their employment terminate/cease during this three year period as noted in the repayment agreement.
