WHEREAS, NEXT Electric, LLC is found to be the lowest responsible responsive bidder.

WHEREAS, at this time the Village would like to proceed with said improvements; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Sturtevant, Racine County, Wisconsin does hereby resolve:

- That the awarding of a contract to NEXT Electric, LLC of Waukesha, Wisconsin, in the amount of \$78,600.00 for the Village Hall Standby Power Improvements Project, and, is hereby authorized and approved.
- That the following projects for the Village Hall Standby Power Improvements Project work is to be completed in 2022 using funds from Account #204-51300-210 and Account #602-62831-350.
- That the total costs for the project shall not exceed \$100,000.00 which includes engineering, legal and administration and contingencies.


Dear Jack:

We have completed our review of bids for the Village Hall Standby Power Improvements, as opened at 10:00 a.m. on May 20, 2022. One bid was received for the project and a summary of the bid is provided below:

We have reviewed the bid and based on our review make the following comments and recommendations for the Village's consideration:

- 1. The low bid for the project was submitted by NEXT Electric, LLC. in the amount of \$78,600.
- 2. The Bid included a 5% Bid Bond from the surety company United States Fire Insurance Company, a certified surety company under Circular 570.
- 3. NEXT Electric, LLC. has experience with this type of project and has completed other similar projects.
- 4. Applied Technologies Inc. finds NEXT Electric, LLC. to be the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder. We recommend that the Village of Sturtevant award the Village Hall Standby Power Improvements contract to NEXT Electric, LLC in the amount of \$78,600.



Following the Village's Award of the contract, we will send a Notice of Award to the contractor along with copies of the Contract Documents for signature. These will be returned to the Village for execution, after which the Notice to Proceed will be issued.
